Success Coaches services are free to employees that are members of the KY ERN®, as part of your employee benefit package. Success Coaches provide confidential services to ensure resolutions of barriers that could potentially eliminate the employee from the workforce.

What is the Kentucky ERN®

Kentucky is in the process of developing Employer Resource Networks® throughout the Commonwealth. The KY ERN® is separated into 10 regions, covering every county in KY. This innovative model to workforce development aims to blend the efforts of business, social service and workforce development agencies to support all employees, but particularly low-wage and entry-level employees, with job retention services, work supports, education, and training.

Kentucky ERN also aims to connect employers with resources and tools to help understand and address issues related to substance use disorder (SUD) and/or opioid use disorder (OUD), particularly supporting Kentuckians in recovery. Kentucky ERN is part of a larger SUD/OUD employment program known as the Strategic Initiative for Transformational Employment (SITE) being implemented by the Eastern Kentucky Concentrated Employment Program (EKCEP)
